Our priority is for students to have a transformative experience, not only academically and linguistically, but also in their personal and social development, from an early age.






Why Spain? Why Seville?

Our academic program

The main objective is for students to learn Spanish in a 100% immersive environment, developing autonomy, confidence, and personal skills in an international context.

Adapted Subjects

We personally advise families on choosing the most appropriate subjects based on the course and student profile.

Classes with native teachers

All students attend local schools with high academic standards.

Much more than studying

The educational experience is complemented by workshops, cultural and sports activities, as well as a motivational coaching program that promotes student personal growth throughout the course.

Performance Tracking

Our team in Spain coordinates with the teachers at each school to monitor the student's academic progress.



Personalized approach



At Spain & Families, we believe that each student's success depends on close, caring support. That's why we offer a unique support system that sets us apart from other agencies.

Personal tutor available 24/7

Each student is assigned a tutor from the moment they arrive in Spain. This person will be their point of contact throughout their stay and will be available 24 hours a day for any academic, personal, or family needs.

Real proximity, not just by phone

Our tutors live within 10 to 15 minutes of their students' homes, allowing for rapid, effective, and consistent intervention.

Continuous academic monitoring

Individual meetings: The tutor meets with the student regularly.

Coordination with teachers:

We monitor student performance by speaking directly with the school's teaching team.

Periodic reports: We send academic and personal reports to families so they are informed of their progress.

Motivational coaching

We hold sessions to help students organize their studies, stay motivated, set goals, and improve their performance. We work on their personal development so they learn to face new challenges with independence and confidence.

Continuous communication

Contact between families, students, and tutors is constant through calls, WhatsApp, and video calls. We ensure that everyone involved stays connected and at ease.

Careful and personalized selection

We personally select our host families, prioritizing their experience, values, and commitment. Each family has been vetted by our team and holds a police vetting certificate of no criminal record.

Total integration

Students participate in family life as one more: They share meals and daily routines.

They follow the same rules as Spanish children.
They integrate into local customs and are fully supported by their host families.

Natural English learning

It's in everyday interaction that students progress most rapidly in the language. By constantly communicating with native speakers in a real-life context, they organically acquire vocabulary, fluency, and confidence.

Mutual commitment

Families not only provide accommodation and meals, but also a truly supportive environment. In return, students are expected to show respect, help with basic household chores (such as setting the table or keeping their room tidy), and have a positive attitude.

MOBILE USE: YOUR BEST ALLY OR YOUR WORST ENEMY

Mobile phone use should be limited. You're in Spain to learn Spanish, and every moment you spend with family or colleagues is an opportunity to improve. Weekly calls with your family in Ireland are welcome, but avoid spending too much time on the screen.

Spain is a country with a deep Catholic tradition. Many families attend Mass on Sundays, and it's a very enriching experience for the students. If they wish, they can join them and experience this part of the local culture.



3 HOMEWORK AND ACADEMIC RHYTHM

Homework is more common in Spain than in Ireland, so discipline and responsibility are still key. Keeping up with schoolwork is essential for successful academic integration.

ATTITUDE AND COEXISTENCE

Remember: you're not a guest, but a member of the family. Help with simple tasks like setting the table or keeping your room tidy. The experience will be much more positive if you show respect, cooperation, and a willingness to integrate.
